Recipe of the Week

Try making Hummus at home with this exciting recipe. Hummus can be eaten as a dip with vegetable or as a spread on sandwiches or wraps and pittas.

Ingredients

- 2 heaped tablespoons tinned chickpeas
- · Juice of half a lemon
- 1 tablespoon low-fat Greek style yoghurt
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- ¼ teaspoon paprika (or to taste)
- ¼ teaspoon cumin (or to taste)
- 1 clove of garlic (peeled)
- 1 large wholemeal pitta bread, cut into strips
- 1 small carrot, cut into sticks
- 1 stick of celery, cut into sticks

Method

- 1. Put the chickpeas, lemon juice, yoghurt, oil, spices and garlic in a bowl.
- 2. Using a hand blender, mix together until smooth.

Make the hummus the previous evening and store in the fridge. As well as saving time, the flavours will have time to develop.

3. Serve with the pitta bread strips and carrot and celery sticks.

Hummus makes a great after-school snack. If you're using a shop-bought hummus, choose a reduced-fat version.
